- Valid Instrument Rating for Multi-Engine Aeroplane (IR(A) ME).
- Medical Certificate Class 1.
- ICAO English Language Proficiency Level 5 or above.
- Valid EU passport.
- A clean criminal record.
- Proficiency in a **Nordic** language is mandatory (Finnish, Danish, Swedish or Norwegian)
- Minimum 500 hours as PIC on the B737NG/MAX
