To clarify, it deviates in its entirety from a traditional 9-17 job and as Cabin Crew you can expect to frequently spend several consecutive nights away from your home base – either at one of our destinations, or at one of our Nordic bases. Requirements

- Minimum age: 20 years
- Fluency in Danish or Swedish and good English language skills is a must.
- High school diploma or 2+ years of work experience in service or healthcare (e.g., travel guide, receptionist, nurse, social worker)
- Stable mental and physical health; able to swim 200 meters unaided
- Able to pass an aeromedical exam and drug/alcohol test*
- Height between 160–195 cm
- Valid EU passport with at least 6 months' validity at course start
- Able to reach CPH Airport within 90 minutes during standby
- Eligible for security clearance and clean criminal record
- Willing to follow Jetttime's uniform policy (visible tattoos must be approved)

Training and Onboarding

You'll attend a 4-week Cabin Crew training course at Jetttime HQ in Copenhagen.

The course is free of charge, and upon successful completion, you'll receive a bonus equivalent to one month's base salary.

Passing all exams, obtaining an approved background check and a Cabin Crew Medical Certificate are required for employment.
